The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Rock Springs Field Office (RSFO) will be preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the “East LaBarge Gas Exploration and Development Project”. EOG Resources, Inc. has indicated their intent to further drill and develop gas resources in the BLM RSFO within Lincoln and Sublette Counties, Wyoming. The project area is located throughout multiple sections within Townships 26 and 27 North, Range 112 West, 6th Principle Meridian.
