The following areas should join Jackson Canyon and the Alcova Fossil Area as Areas of Critical Environmental Concern: a. Southern Bighorns/Red Wall, the entire 372,872 acres for outstanding scenery and important grassland ecosystem b. Cedar Ridge - For cultural resources c. Black-tailed Prairie Dog complex because of the rarity of this species throughout the North American Prairie. d. The North Platte River from Alcova Reservoir to Casper, for its outstanding fisheries, scenery, historical significance and recreation. 3) The South Fork of the Powder River be proposed for wilderness designation.
