Noxious pest management needs to become a higher priority on public lands. It is disappointing that a federal agency will, under the Preferred Alternative, address only one-half the acres invested with invasive nonnative plant species. Specifically, on page 2-52, salt cedar should be eliminated, not reduced or eliminated. Salt cedar is extremely adaptable to the area and should be eliminated before spreading any farther, especially to private lands. The BLM must improve its knowledge concerning spread of annual nonnative grasses. Once well established, these undesirable plants will be extremely difficult to cont
