ERRATA NOTICE

The Draft Coeur d'Alene RMP/EIS (January 2006) contains an error in the description of forest vegetation management for Alternatives C and D, in the Executive Summary (page ES-4) and in the Description of the Alternatives (pages 2-4 and 2-5). These descriptions were inadvertently reversed. Please apply the following corrections to the specified sections of the document:

Executive Summary, page ES-4 under Alternative C (Minimal Active Management - Preservation Emphasis), and Section 2.4.3 page 2-5:

Delete:

- ~~Management of forest vegetation allows for an intermediate level of commodity production with a probable sale quantity of 880 MBF [4.4 MMBF in Section 2.4.3] per year, while providing protection to other resources.~~

Replace with:

- Management of forest vegetation focuses on areas where natural disturbance (e.g., wildland fire, disease) has occurred, yielding a probable sale quantity of 880 MBF per year.

Executive Summary, page ES-4, Alternative D (Preferred Alternative) and Section 2.4.4 page 2-6:

Delete:

- ~~Management of forest vegetation focuses on areas where natural disturbance (e.g., wildland fire, disease) has occurred, yielding a probable sale quantity of 4.4 MMBF [880 MBF in Section 2.4.4] per year.~~

Replace with:

- Management of forest vegetation allows for an intermediate level of commodity production with a probable sale quantity of 4.4 MMBF per year, while providing protection to other resources.
