



## Proposed RMP/Final EIS Released


A Notice of Availability for the PRMP/FEIS will be published in the *Federal Register* on October 27, 2006. This will initiate a 30-day public protest period, which ends on November 26, 2006. During this period, any person or organization who has participated in the Coeur d'Alene RMP process, and who has an interest which is or may be adversely affected, may protest approval of the PRMP to the Director of BLM. The "Dear Reader" letter, found at the front of the PRMP/FEIS, contains detailed instructions for filing a protest.

## What's in the Proposed RMP/Final EIS?

**T**he PRMP/FEIS contains four alternatives and outlines the environmental effects of these alternatives. Alternative D, a slightly revised version of the Preferred Alternative in the Draft RMP/EIS, is the Proposed Action (Proposed RMP). The PRMP/FEIS includes changes to the draft as a result of comments we received, consultation with the Coeur d'Alene Tribe and US Fish and Wildlife Service, and other new information. Chapter 1 of the PRMP/FEIS provides more detail on

these changes. Only 12 of the 71 maps in the draft were revised and are included in the printed version of the PRMP/FEIS. For all other maps, you must refer to Volume III of the draft. All maps (revised and unrevised) are included on the CD version of the PRMP/FEIS and are on the Web site (<http://www.blm.gov/rmp/id/cda>). Printed copies of Volume III of the Draft RMP/EIS are available on request at the Coeur d'Alene Field Office (see information above regarding how to request copies).
