20	<p>We, the undersigned Wyoming citizens, are very concerned about the cultural resources, wildlife and their critical habitat, and recreational opportunities in the Great Divide Country. We understand that the proposed BLM Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Study released on Dec. 17, 2004 does NOT adequately protect these public resources. Nearly, 9,000 oil, gas and coal-bed methane wells and over 2,600 miles of roads through the area is NOT a balanced approach to protecting the unique 12,000 year-old history of humankind or over 350 species of wildlife that live in OUR Great Divide Country. PLEASE consider the Western heritage Alternative as the Citizens' preference for balanced development.</p>
