

1. Green River:

Flaming Gorge Dam to Little Hole (7 miles)
 USFS Dutch John, UT 435 885-3318
 No permit required for noncommercial use
 No camping on river or at Little Hole
 Little Hole Picnic area: Overnight parking, boat ramp, flush toilets.
 Camping toilet midway to Little Hole

2. Green River:

Little Hole to Utah State Line (23 miles)
 BLM Vernal, UT 435 781-4400
 No permit required
 Camping is allowed
 No horses allowed on Forest Land
 Horses allowed on BLM Land but not at the campsite.
 Best take out points are Indian Crossing, Bridge Hollow and Swallow Canyon.
 Campground at Bridge Hollow: drinking water, toilets and credit card phone.
 Campground at Indian Crossing: boat ramp, drinking water, toilets and dump station.
 Indian Crossing to State Line (14 miles)

Campsites near Jarvie

Vernal BLM 885-3307
 Group campsite, \$30 per night. Pay on arrival.
 2 p.m. check out.
 Indian Crossing: Up to 30 people/site. You can reserve an individual site only in conjunction with a group reservation (\$5/8 people max)
 No horses in developed campground.

3. Green River:

State Line to Gates of Lodore (16 miles)
 USF&WS Browns Park, CO 970 365-3613 Mike Bryant Mgr
 Camping is permitted
 Campground, toilets and parking at state line
 Swinging Bridge Campground: toilets and parking.
 Crook Campground (8 miles down from Swinging Bridge): boat ramp
 Stay in river corridor.

4. Green River:

Gates of Lodore through Monument to Split Mountain and Yampa River (45 miles)
 USPS 4545 Hwy 40, Dinosaur, CO 81610
 Park Service Permit Required.
 To obtain a permit or cancelled river permit, call 8:00 a.m. - noon live, or after noon a recording at 970 374-2468.
 Send self-addressed, stamped legal envelope to 4545 Hwy 40, Dinosaur, CO 81610. They will send you one application per envelope.

U.S. Park Service 789-2115 (quarry)
 Entrance Fee \$10/vehicle

A. Lodore Campground (Browns Park)

17 units, drinking water, ranger station, tables, fire rings, boat ramp, nature trail \$6.

B. Split Mountain Campground

Reservations for group sites only. Each site 20 people max. 4 Group sites. \$10 nonrefundable reservation fee plus \$25/night/site.

C. Green River Campground


Open April 1 \$12
 88 units, tent, RV, flush toilets, tables, firewood sales, ranger station, evening talks, drinking water

 40 mile flatwater section before monument.
 Above this section unrunnable at flows above 4,000 cfs even in kayak

 Camping free on BLM lands.

Ouray National Wildlife Refuge Boat Ramp:
 Unimproved ramp located midway between Sheppard
 and Leotta Bottoms. Free. River right. Gate to refuge
 open only 1 hour before or

**Sandwash through Gray and Desolation Canyon to
 Green River, Utah (not shown) (145.5 miles)**

 If you plan to leave a vehicle overnight at the Mountain
 Fuel Bridge on the Indian Reservation you are to contact
 BIA at 435 722-5511, Fort Duchesne for permit. Please
 sign register at take-out..
