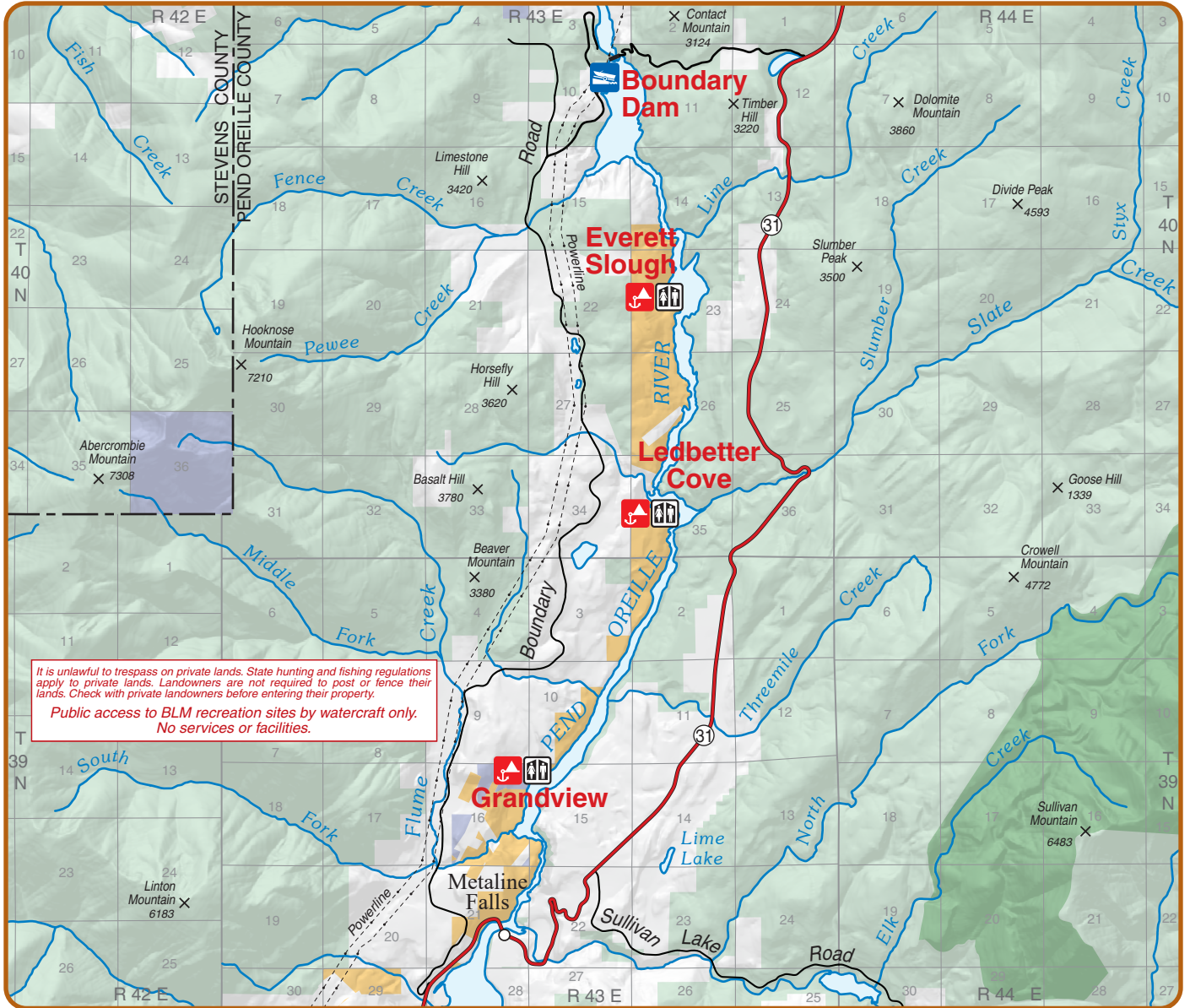
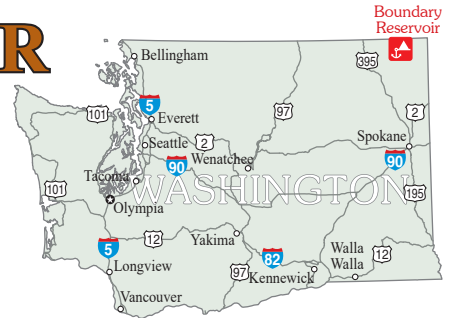

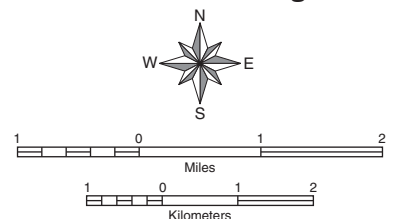
Public access to BLM recreation sites by watercraft only. No services or facilities.
