When finalizing your draft resource plan for the Lower Sonoran Field Office and the Sonoran Desert National Monument Please consider:

Protection of the Sand Tank Mountains for their wilderness characteristics.

Inclusion of Margies Peak and Butterfield Stage units in the monument's inventory.

Increase the number and size of areas managed for wilderness including Face mountain, Columbus Peak, And Yellow Medicine Butte.

We feel very strongly that allowing motorized vehicle on designated routes is a critical step in reducing the proliferation of roads across the landscape, but it is only successful if law enforcement and route signage is properly in place. Some of these areas might benefit from a phone number or some type of contact info for those who witness destructive behavior. We hope to see the closure of unnecessary, user-created routes.

We hope you will support Alternative D which promotes a healthier and safer migration corridor.
