INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a W.& L.E.Gurley Mountain transit fitted with a Burt Solar by which the true meridian was obtained and checked upon previously determined courses. Measurements were made with a 300 foot steel tape.

Remarks.

The lines of this survey were run directly upon the ground and agree with the original corners in the field.

I could determine no corner in the field on the northeast end line of Old Dominion lode, Lot No. 45, and hence I have figured intersections and area in conflict as same should exist by notes of said survey.

NOTICE OF MINING LOCATION

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim, the name of which is the VIRGIN LADY Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purposes of exploration and purchase by N.L. Amster, a citizen of the United States, the undersigned, on the 24th day of May, 1912.

The length of this claim is 1345 feet, and I claim 595 feet, in a N. 16° 42' E. direction and 750 feet in a S. 16° 42' W. direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the Northeast to the Southwest.

The claim is situated and located in the Globe Mining District, in Gila County, in the Territory of Arizona, about 3½ miles in a northwesterly direction from Globe and about ¼ of a mile east from the O.D. Keystone.

The surface boundaries of the claim are marked upon the ground as follows: Beginning at 4 x 4 pine post at a point in a N. 16° 42' E. direction 595 feet from the discovery shaft (at which this notice is posted), being in the center of the N.E. end line of said claim; thence 300 feet to a 4 x 4 pine post, being the N.E. corner of said claim; thence S. 16° 42' W. 1345 feet to a 4 x 4 pine post being at the S.E. corner of said claim; thence N. 73° 18' W. 300 feet to a 4 x 4 pine post at the center of the S.W. end of said claim; thence 300 feet to a 4 x 4 post, being at the S.W. corner of said claim; thence N. 16° 42' E. 1345 feet to a 4 x 4 post at the N.W. corner of said claim; thence 300 feet to the place of beginning.
