INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons Light Mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by a Solar observation. The distances were measured with a 300 ft steel tape. Magnetic variation 12° 30' East at all corners.

REPORT.

The south 1/4 Cor of Sec 36, T 23 S, R 24 E, is a sandstone rock 7 x 9.5 x 10 ins high with 1/4 chiseled on north face.

AMENDED
NOTICE OF MINING LOCATION
LODE CLAIM

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim, the name of which is the San Antonio Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purposes of exploration and purchase by John Treu a citizen of the United States, the undersigned, on the 8th day of June, 1915.

The length of this claim is 1500 feet, and I claim 175 feet in an easterly direction and 1325 feet in a westerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the west to the east

The claim is situated and located in the Warren Mining District, in Cochise County, in the State of Arizona, about 2 miles in a southeasterly direction from the post office at Warren, and is located in Sec 36, Tp 23 S. R 24 E, about 1200 ft in a northerly direction from the south 1/4 Cor of said section.

The surface boundaries of the claim are marked upon the ground as follows: Beginning at a monument of stones at a point in a easterly direction 175 feet from the discovery shaft (at which this notice is posted), being in the center of the east end line of said claim; thence southerly 300 feet to a post and monument, being the southeast corner of said claim; thence westerly 1500 feet to a post and monument, being at the southwest corner of said claim; thence northerly 300 feet to a monument of stone at the center of the west end of said claim; thence northerly 300 feet to a post and monument, being at the northwest corner of said claim; thence easterly 1500 feet to a post and monument at the northeast corner of said claim;
