Corners No.5 and 6 are stones properly set and chiseled with the number of corner and survey; cor.No.8 is missing but the bearing rock is still in place; cor. No.7 is missing as are also the two bearings, so the point for corner was established by intersection of a line from Cor.No.6, run to intersect the end line of the Arkansas Lode, previously established and located on the side line of the No.7 lode, when corners of said lode were in position. I do not agree with the courses of the side lines of above mentioned lode.

The discrepancies found existing between the claims as marked by the location monuments and as described in the location notices are due to errors in the location notices. The discrepancies between the lines of this survey and of other prior approved surveys, are due to errors in the latter.


