INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Surley Solar Transit. The courses were deflected from the meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The lode line of this claim was run direct upon the ground and the corners were established by means of offsets from the lode line. The tie line was run direct upon the ground.

Cor. No. 1 Sur. No. 2107 Budd lode is a schist stone 5X10X15 ins. with mound of stones chiseled 1-5-2107.

The Lone Jack lode Sur. No. 1645 is about 75 ft. south of this claim but I could not find any corners thereof.

Cor. to secs. 1, 6, 7 & 12 is a pipe about 12 ins. above the ground, with brass cap properly marked.

U.S.M.M. No. 2, Pine Grove Mining District is a granite boulder 3 X 3 X 3 ft. with small mound of stones, chiseled X U.S. M.M. No. 2 P.G.
