LOCATION.

REPORT.

The side and end lines and all other lines were run directly on the ground.

Sur. No. 3264, Pyramid Rock and Dam Site lodes, the corner tied to was a rock, properly set and marked with the number of the corner and survey.

The cor. of secs. 1 and 12 is an iron post, with a brass cap properly marked.

U. S. L. M. 3264 is the top of Pyramid Rock on the bank of the Colorado River.

This mill site is to be used for mining or milling purposes in connection with the lode claims surveyed in Sur. No. 3264, and for that reason tie was given to those claims.

INSTRUMENT AND MERIDIAN.

The survey was made with a 500 ft. tape and a Berger Mining transit.

The meridian was determined by hour angle observation on polaris.

CONFLICTING AND SURROUNDING CLAIMS.

There are no outside conflicts with the claims of this survey and it is surrounded by public domain.

The difference between the ^{location} notice and the survey is due to error in the former.


