LOCATION.

This survey is located in the N.E. 1/4 Sec. 28, Unsurveyed, T.10 S.,
R. 16 E., In the Coronado National Forest, Old Hat Mining District,
Pinal County, Arizona.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Gurley mountain transit, the courses
were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct Solar
observations. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The corners were established by running around the Mill Site.

The tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The 1/4 Cor. bet. Secs. 21 and 28, T.10 S., R. 16 E. is an iron
post capped with brass, stamped 1/4 S. 21, S. 28.

Cor. No.2 Sur. No.4088 Mischief lode consists of an iron pipe 2 ins.
diam. with cap on top, properly set and stamped with the number of
the corner and the survey.

Sur. No.748, Independent Mill Site. Cor. No.4 is a very old, well
built monument. The post has rotted completely away, but was identified
the Cor.

by four bearing trees, still standing. No other corners of this survey could be found or identified, its conflict with this survey was therefore calculated from the record.

Sur. No. 2108 B Lewis Mill Site. Cor. Nos. 2 and 3 consist of pine posts 4 ins. sq. with copper plates, stamped Lewis Millsite.

Line 2-3 fails to furnish the course and distance as approved and same is properly given in these field notes. (N.13°30'W.330.')

The Mill Site area herein applied for is necessary in connection with the mining operations of the Sur. No.4088 Mischief lode belonging to claimant herein. The foundation has been completed and the mill is in the course of construction.


