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CHAINS

The south boundary, Fourth Standard Parallel North, was surveyed in 1883 by J. B. McLaughlin. The east, west and north boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1883-84 by W. B. Neil.

The following field notes are those of remonumentation of cadastral survey corners by agreement with the U. S. Forest Service. The detailed cooperative agreement was approved by the Director, Bureau of Land Management, by memorandum (5.04b) dated October 16, 1958.

The approval of the Special Instructions on June 22, 1964, gave authority to proceed with the remonumentation in accordance with the Director's order No. 541, dated April 21, 1961.

The assistants furnished by the Forest Service remonumented the original corner positions after verification. An open site compass was used to obtain the bearings and a standard steel tape was used to measure the distances to the corner accessories.

Remonumentation, Township 20 South, Range 31 East, Arizona

The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15 is monumented by a malpais stone 12x16x18 ins., loosely set, mkd. with 4 notches on the S. and 2 notches on the E., with a small mound of stones to the W.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Build a mound of stones to the W. of the iron post.

Bury the original corner stone in the mound of stones W. of the iron post.

Cor. is on a gentle NE. slope and in an old fence which is mostly down.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11 is monumented by a granite stone 12x22x28 ins., firmly set, mkd. ¼ on the W.

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Build a mound of stones 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, to the W. of the iron post.

CHAINS

Put the original corner stone in the mound of stones to the W. of the iron post.

Cor. is on the S. slope of a high rocky hill about 4 chs. from the top, and in an old N. and S. fence which has mostly fallen over.

The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16 is monumented by a malpais stone 5x14x18 ins., loosely set on solid rock, mkd. with 4 notches on the S. and 3 notches on the E., with a mound of stones to the W.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock and in a mound of stones with 4 ft. base to the top, with brass cap mkd.
