
The accommodation would be greatly appreciated, and we would like to be advised when the work has been done so that the notation may be made on the official records.

Reference is had to Homestead Entry Survey No. 456 in sec. 27, T. 13 N., R. 12 E., G. & S. R. M., Arizona, accepted November 15, 1917, embracing a tract of land containing 17.25 acres in the Sitgreaves National Forest, pursuant to restoration list No. 3-1834 under the act of June 11, 1906 (34 Stat. 233).

According to our records, the entries for this tract have been either relinquished or canceled, and on August 11, 1921, the order of restoration list No. 3-1834 was revoked by the Department upon the request of the Acting Secretary, Department of Agriculture, dated July 20, 1921.

All of sec. 27 is part of the land for which patent is to be issued to the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company pursuant to the Transportation Act of 1940 (54 Stat. 954; 49 U.S.C. sec. 65). It is in the Company's indemnity selection, Phoenix 080632, under the act of July 27, 1866 (14 Stat. 292). Civil No. 23477, Santa Fe Pacific Rail-road Company and Aztec Land and Cattle Company v. Chapman and Clawson in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

Since the restoration under the act of June 11, 1906 has been revoked and the court has held that sec. 27 should be patented to the railroad company for the use of the Aztec Land and Cattle Company pursuant to the provisions of the Transportation Act of 1940, the plat of Homestead Entry Survey No. 456 is hereby canceled. Appropriate notations to this effect have been placed on our records. At a future convenient time the corners of this survey should be removed.
