#### Hn Act to Codify and Revise the Laws of the Territory of Arizona.

SECTIONS 1-11.-INC. LOCATION OF CLAIMS. Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Arizona: SECTION 1. On the discovery of mineral in places on the public domain of the United States, the same may be located as a mineral claim by the discoverer for himself, for himself and others, or for others.

SECTION 2. Such location shall be made by creeting at or contiguous to the point of discovery, a conspicuous monument of stones not less than three (3) feet in height, or an upright post securely fixed, projecting at least four (4) feet above the ground, in which monument of stones or on which post, there shall be posted a location notice, which shall be signed by the name or names of the locator or locators.
