Subject: Participation in NTC Pathways and Leadership Challenge Courses

One of California's foundations for effectively dealing with workforce planning issues is to ensure we are actively participating in the employee leadership development courses offered at the National Training Center. Preliminary observations indicate that planned participation this fiscal year does not adequately reflect the investment we have made in recruiting new employees to our California workforce. I am asking each of you to aggressively work with your supervisory staff to identify and enroll appropriate personnel in these leadership development courses.
