Training Session Information

This annual safety training week is sponsored by the Oregon State BLM Safety Office. All agency employees and members of the public are invited to attend any of the sessions.

- Employees must hold a valid 1st Aid card to attend the **Adult CPR/AED Recertification** training scheduled for Monday afternoon. First aid cards are valid for 3 years. CPR/AED recertification is required each year through the American Red Cross.

*A full session for **Standard 1st Aid/CPR/AED** is scheduled for Wednesday, February 7. **All agency employees are encouraged to become 1st Aid/CPR/AED trained.***

- **The Defensive Driver Training** (Positive Driving) is required of all agency employees, contractors, and volunteers who drive government vehicles. *(Initial training should be completed upon hire; and, a refresher course completed each 3 years.)*
- **Wilderness First Aid** – This class is designed to meet the needs of people working outside of the urban environment. It is an intensive course for those who may have to provide first aid care for extended periods of time without rapid emergency medical service response; e.g., cadastral and other survey and monitoring employees, trail crews, recreation technicians, etc.

Topics covered in this course include patient assessment and reporting, basic life support techniques, spinal precautions, muscle-skeletal immobilization, wound management, environmental emergencies care, sudden illness diagnosis and care, severe allergic reactions, burn care, shock treatment, and personal protection and care. The class is very “hands-on” with numerous skills sessions and group-directed discussions. Each participant is asked to bring the items they would routinely have with them when working in the field, such as first aid kits, any specific outdoor gear used, etc. as these items will be incorporated in the training.

Participants receive Emergency Care Handbook, Nitrile gloves, and WFA certification card good for three years.

- **First Responder Awareness & Operations Refresher Training** – OSHA regulations require initial 8-hour training for employees who need to know how to recognize a potential emergency or the potential need for emergency response. Annual refresher training is also required to maintain certification. Field-going employees are encouraged to attend this class, regardless of occupation.
