BLM TO OFFER FREE WILD HORSE MANURE TO THE PUBLIC

BURNS, Oregon – Anyone interested in obtaining free, quality fertilizer for their spring gardening needs can make a trip to Oregon's Wild Horse Corral Facility in Hines on Saturday, May 5 for a load or two of wild horse manure.

The Corral Facility, located at milepost 122 just west of Hines, will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for open-top pickups and trailers which will be loaded with a front-end loader on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is no set limit on the amount of wild horse manure that can be obtained during the day; however, the offer does not apply to commercial haulers.

This will be the only day in 2007 when wild horse manure will be available to the public.
