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CRUISE INFORMATION: With respect to merchantable trees of all species in all cruise strata: the average DBHOB is 11.5 inches: the average gross merchantable log contains 37 bd. ft.; the total gross volume is approximately 5735 thousand bd. ft.; and 93% recovery is expected. The average DBHOB for Douglas-fir is 11.3 inches; and the average gross merchantable log contains 35 bd. ft. None of the total sale volume is salvage material. The following cruise methods were used for volume determination:

VARIABLE PLOT: Timber volumes were based on a variable plot cruise using the Behre's volume equation or form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Two hundred and sixty-three (263 of plots) plots were measured using a twenty (20) basal area factor (BAF). Two hundred and three (203 of trees) trees were randomly selected to be cruised.

SAMPLE TREE CRUISE: Timber volumes have been cruised using the sample tree system to select sample trees. The Douglas-fir sample trees were cruised using the Behres volume equation or form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Hemlock sample trees were cruised using form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. The volumes are then expanded to a total sale volume.

CUTTING AREA: Six (6) units totaling three hundred sixty-four (364) acres must be partial cut.

ACCESS: Access to the sale area is provided by Oregon State highways; Coos County roads, Government controlled roads, and privately controlled roads.

DIRECTIONS TO SALE AREA: From Myrtle Point, travel east on Myrtle Point - Sitkum Road for approximately 25.0 miles. Turn left onto Brummit Creek County Road. Refer to Exhibits A and A-1 for unit locations.

ROAD USE & MAINTENANCE: Refer to Exhibit E Summary attached. Operator maintenance required on 6.8 miles of road.

The average DBHOB for Douglas-fir is 12.3 inches; and the average gross merchantable log contains 41 bd. ft. The following cruise methods were used for volume determination:

VARIABLE PLOT: Timber volumes were based on a variable plot cruise using the Behres volume equation or form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Five-hundred sixty nine (569) plots were measured using a 20 basal area factor (BAF). Three-thousand eighty six (3686) trees were randomly selected to be cruised.

LOCAL VOLUME TABLE: Timber volumes have been cruised using the local volume table system to select sample trees. The Douglas-fir sample trees were cruised using the Behres volume equation or form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Hemlock sample trees were cruised using form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. The volumes are then expanded to a total sale volume.

CUTTING AREA: Twenty (20) units totaling approximately 620 acres must be partial cut.

ACCESS: Access to the sale area is provided via Oregon State highways, Coos County roads, Government controlled roads, and privately controlled roads.

DIRECTIONS TO SALE AREA: From Hwy 42, at Ten Mile, OR, turn north onto Reston Road to the Flournoy Valley (Coos Bay Wagon Road). Turn left (west) onto the Flournoy Valley road for approximately 1.5 miles to BLM Burnt Mt. Access road (28-8-16.0). Turn right (north) onto the Burnt Mt Access Road and proceed approximately 18 miles west to the junction of the 27-10-35.2 road (Burnt Mt Tie).
