A. Description of the Proposed Action:

Proposed Action Title/Type: Bastendorff Beach Jetty Restroom

Location / Legal Description: Bastendorff Beach, Coos County, OR T. 26 S., R. 14 W., Sec. 3 WM. This is in the southeast portion of the jetty parking area.

Proposed Action:

Install a second double vault restroom at the jetty lot at Bastendorff Beach.

B. Land Use Plan (LUP) Conformance

This project is tiered to and in conformance with the *Coos Bay District Resource Management Plan/Final Environmental Impact Statement* (USDI BLM 1994) and its *Record of Decision (ROD/RMP)*, as supplemented and amended. The Coos Bay ROD/RMP is supported by and consistent with the *Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (FSEIS) on Management of Habitat for Late Successional and Old Growth Forest Related Species Within the Range of the Northern Spotted Owl* (Northwest Forest Plan [NFP]) (USDA/USDI 1994) and its *Record of Decision* (USDA/USDI 1994a).

This project was initiated and designed to conform and be consistent with the Coos Bay District 1995 RMP. Following the March 31, 2011 decision by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in *Douglas Timber Operators et al. v. Salazar*, which vacated and remanded the administrative withdrawal of the Coos Bay District 2008 ROD and RMP, this project was evaluated for consistency with both.

- The proposed action is in conformance with the applicable LUP because it is specifically provided for in the following LUP decisions: “Manage scenic, natural, and cultural resources to enhance visitor recreation experience expectations and to satisfy public land users.” P. 46.

- The proposed action is in conformance with the applicable LUPs, even though it is not specifically provided for, because it is clearly consistent with the following LUP decisions (Objectives, terms, and conditions): Bastendorff Beach area was designated as a Special Recreation Management Area (SRMA), included in the Coos Bay Shorelands SRMA. P. 48 RMP; and The Coos Bay Shorelands Management Plan 1995, BLM Coos Bay District, Umpqua Field Office.


C. Identify applicable NEPA document(s) and other related documents that cover the proposed action.

Bastendorff Beach Restroom and Parking Lot EA No. DOI-BLM-OR-CO30-2009-0010-EA, August, 2009, Coos Bay BLM. Bastendorff Beach Draft Cooperative Management Plan - no objections were made during the draft comment period ending 03/15/11.

D. NEPA Adequacy Criteria.

1. Is the new proposed action a feature of, or essentially similar to, an alternative analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s)? Is the project within the same analysis area, or if the project location is different, are the geographic and resource conditions sufficiently similar to those analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s)? If there are differences, can you explain why they are not substantial?

Documentation of answer and explanation: The project is essentially the same as the first restroom installation. It is nearby and would disturb primarily non-native, invasive beach grass and scotch broom. The visitors are the same, the activities occurring in the area are the same and the project is simply adding another sanitation facility to enhance visitor experience on site. All natural resources are essentially the same and there are no known T&E species in the project area.
