


South Fork Complex Post-Fire Herbicide Application



South Fork Complex Spraying Treatment



The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Prineville District will be applying the herbicide imazapic in the date range of March 14-26, 2016 (weather dependent) to several thousand acres of non-native and invasive plants in areas burned by the 2014 South Fork Complex. We will be using aerial (helicopter) methods to perform this work.

Spraying will occur on BLM lands within the Murderer's Creek watershed.

Target plants: Medusahead rye, cheatgrass, and North Africa grass (ventenata)



For safety, neighboring residents and the public should stay out of these areas during spraying and for 12 hours after spraying is complete. All public entrances to these lands will be posted with herbicide and closure information.
