

FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE

Due to extreme fire danger within the Prineville District BLM, pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.2 (a), fire restrictions have been established as follows:

Beginning, Tuesday, August 21, 2012, **campfires, warming fires and cooking fires, including charcoal fires are prohibited** except in established fire rings at the following Crooked River campgrounds:

Castle Rock, Still Water, Lone Pine, Palisades,
Chimney Rock, Cobble Rock, Post Pile, and Poison Butte.

Portable cooking stoves or lanterns using liquefied or bottled fuel are allowed.

Smoking is restricted to enclosed vehicles or buildings, boats on water, developed campgrounds, or while standing in water.

Pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.3 (a), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any federal, state, or local officer or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Operating a cooking stove or lantern using liquefied or bottled fuels.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1000 or to imprisonment of not more than 12 months, or both.
