Cascade View Trailhead Project

This site is the location of the Cascade View Trailhead, which will provide access to pedestrian, equestrian and mountain bike trails planned for the portion of the Cline Buttes Recreation Area east of Barr Road and west of Cline Falls Highway.

The Cascade View Trailhead will accommodate 27 single vehicles and 12 to 14 horse trailers. A vault toilet and small picnic area will also be provided at the site.

This project will also develop and designate trails in the buttes trail use area, focusing initial trail work on the areas on the north and west sides of the buttes.

With the exception of Eagle Crest Blvd and the Cline Buttes Rock Pit road, the BLM lands on the buttes are closed to motor vehicle use. The planned trail system will provide for a separated system of horse and mountain bike trails.

Funding for this project includes a Recreation Trails Program Grant administered by the Oregon Department of Parks and Recreation. Partners for this project include Eagle Crest Resort, Oregon Equestrian Trails, Central Oregon Trails Alliance, International Mountain Bike Association and others.
