


# HAMPTON BUTTE & COUGAR WELL Wilderness Study Areas (WSA)

 Decimal Degrees grid ticks, NAD 83 (shown in red) Contour Interval 20 feet (shown in brown)



# Hampton Butte & Cougar Well Wilderness Study Areas

## Visitor Information

Hampton Butte (10,600 acres) and Cougar Well (17,315 acres) Wilderness Study Areas are public lands which are under consideration for wilderness designation by Congress. These lands are managed by the Bureau of Land Management in a manner which maintains their suitability for preservation as wilderness.

Please respect the following regulations:

- **Vehicle Use:**
  - Motorized vehicle use is limited to roads signed as designated routes as depicted on the map.
  - Cross-country travel on foot or horseback is allowed; however, cross-country vehicle travel is strictly prohibited.
  - Violations of motor vehicle use restrictions are subject to a fine up to \$1000 and/or imprisonment.
- **Leave No Trace:**
  - Leave a clean camp by practicing the "Pack it In, Pack it Out" ethic and leave the site better than as you found it.
  - Give wildlife a break: camp away from watering areas.
  - Use dead and down wood for campfires; the cutting of live vegetation or standing dead trees is prohibited.
- **Private Property:**
  - Obtain land owner permission before crossing private land.
