## Mayfield Pond Recreation Area

WELCOME TO THE MAYFIELD POND RECREATION AREA

The Mayfield Pond Recreation Area is 19,500 acres of open space managed by the Prineville District BLM. This area is bordered by Powell Butte Highway to the West, Alfalfa Market Road to the South and Johnson Ranch Road to the east. Motor vehicles are allowed on certain designated roads (marked with green dots). Equestrians, bicyclists and pedestrians can also use these green dot roads, along with the rest of the routes and trails in the area. The long term goal for the area is to develop a trail system for equestrian and other non-motorized trail uses while improving wildlife habitat.

Wildlife such as, mule deer, pronghorn, osprey, red-tailed hawks, bluebirds and flickers use this area. Old growth juniper woodland and open shrub-steppe grassland provide important habitat for wildlife.

There are private parcels both within and adjacent to the recreation area, including private land on the west side of Mayfield Pond. Please enjoy this area, respect the travel route designations, and be a good neighbor to those that live adjacent to these public lands. Hunting is allowed in the area, however, target shooting within 1/2 mile of Mayfield Pond is not.

**Motorized Use in Mayfield Pond Recreation Area is limited to Designated Motorized Routes signed with green dots.**
