Lone Rock Boat Launch Closed

The Bureau of Land Management's Roseburg District Office is announcing the closure of the Lone Rock Boat Launch and Day-Use Area, located approximately one mile east of Glide. The closure will be in effect from August 10 – September 8. During this time, the launch and stairs leading to the river will be replaced to provide enhanced public safety.

About the BLM:

The BLM manages more land – 256 million acres – than any other Federal agency. This land, known as the National System of Public Lands, is primarily located in 12 Western states, including Alaska. The Bureau, with a budget of about \$1 billion, also administers 700 million acres of sub-surface mineral estate throughout the nation.
