## BLM Recreation Sites Getting a Facelift

The Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Roseburg District Office has announced that from March 5 through March 26, 2010, the recreation sites at the Swiftwater and Wolf Creek Trailheads and the Swiftwater Day-use Area will continue to undergo maintenance upgrades.

During this maintenance period the sites may be closed to vehicles for several days at a time. Pedestrian traffic will be permitted outside the work area. A public notification will be made when the projects are complete.

About the BLM: The BLM manages more land – 253 million surface acres – than any other Federal agency.
