Millpond Campground Well Maintenance

Roseburg, Ore. – The Bureau of Land Management’s (BLM) Roseburg District Office has announced that from June 7 through June 16, 2010, there will be maintenance work completed on the water system at the Millpond Campground. Recreational sites affected by this work include Millpond Campground, Millpond Day Use, Millpond Pavilion, Rock Creek Campground and Rock Creek Day Use. These recreation sites will remain open during this period. However, it is recommended that campers at these recreation sites provide their own drinking water.
