Booth organizers will display the entries at the Sportsmen's Show so that visitors can vote for their favorite two photos in each category. The top three photos for each category will receive prizes which include sporting goods, gift certificates and camping passes.

Contest Rules:

1. Photos must be taken on, or of, public lands in the Umpqua Basin (Douglas County Parks, Roseburg BLM land or Umpqua National Forest land) within the last two years
2. A hardcopy 5-inch by 7-inch photograph is required for the contest
3. Photos may be color or black and white
4. Photographs may not be enhanced digitally except for cropping and contrast
5. Submit up to 2 photos per category (8 photo maximum)
6. Please include name, telephone number, email address, location, and category selected on the back of each photo or on an accompanying notecard
7. Photos submitted electronically will not be accepted.
8. No framed or matted photos
9. Photos entries must be mailed or delivered to the following address no later than Wednesday, February 4, at 4:30 p.m.,
