Road Closure of Middle Creek Due to Chip Sealing

Roseburg, Ore. – The Roseburg District, Bureau of Land Management will close Middle Creek Road for chip sealing, beginning on Monday September 12, 2016.

Middle Creek is roughly 11 miles northwest of Glendale, Oregon, located along the Cow Creek Back Country Byway.

Work is expected to be completed by September 15, 2016.
