CRUISE INFORMATION

3P (Fall, Buck & Scale & Volume Table Cruise Combined)

The Douglas-fir and has been cruised using the 3P system to select sample trees. Part of the sample trees have been felled, bucked and scaled and the remainder have been cruised and their volume computed on form class tables for estimating volume in 16-foot lengths. The sample tree volumes were expanded to a total sale volume.

The volume of all other species has been determined by individual tree measurements using a 100% cruise.

With respect to merchantable trees of all species: the average tree is 11.4" D.B.H.O.B., the average log contains 33 bd. ft., the total gross volume is approximately 3106 M bd. ft., and 92% recovery is expected.
