Yaquina Head Lighthouse Winter Tour Schedule

Newport, Ore. – Beginning November 1, BLM’s historic Yaquina Head Lighthouse will be open for guided tours on Saturdays, Sundays, Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays; tours will not be offered on Tuesdays or Thursdays.

Tours will run at 12:00pm, 1:00pm, 2:00pm and 3:00pm, on a first-come first-served basis. Visitors can sign up on the day of a tour beginning at 10:00am at the Interpretive Center.

The park entrance fee is \$7.00/vehicle (3-Day Pass). Accepted passes include Yaquina Head Annual Pass, Oregon Pacific Coast Passport Annual or 5-Day, and Federal Annual, Senior/Golden Age, Military, Access, Volunteer and Every Kid in a Park Passes.

The Interpretive Center will be open 10:00am until 4:00pm. Please call for additional information. All other areas of the park will be open from 8:00am to sunset. For more information about Yaquina Head Outstanding Natural Area contact the BLM at (541) 574-3100.
