The park entrance fee is \$7.00/vehicle (3-Day Pass). Accepted passes include the Yaquina Head Annual Pass, the Oregon Pacific Coast Passport, and the Federal Annual, Golden Age, Military, Access, Volunteer and Every Kid in a Park Passes.
