Yaquina Head Lighthouse Closed for Annual Maintenance March 5-9, 2012

Salem, Ore. – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) at Yaquina Head Outstanding Natural Area will close the historic Yaquina Head Lighthouse to the public beginning Monday, March 5 through Friday, March 9 while the Lighthouse receives a new coat of paint on the staircase and interior walls. The Lighthouse will reopen to the public on March 10, at its regular hours between 12:00 and 4:00 pm. All other areas of the park will remain open from dawn to dusk while the lighthouse is painted. The interpretive center will be open from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.
