The timber described below was offered for sale on May 25, 2011; no bids were received; therefore, pursuant to 43 CFR 5443.1 the sale of such timber is kept open for a period of 30 days. This sale closes July 1, 2011.

Written bids will be received for not less than the advertised appraised price during the time this sale is open. The required deposit must accompany the bid. Notice of receipt of any bids submitted on this sale will be posted for a period of seven days during which time other written bids may be submitted. If no other bids are submitted within the seven-day period, the sole bidder shall be deemed the high bidder. If more than one written bid is submitted, an oral auction will be held after notice to the bidders.

LOG EXPORT AND SUBSTITUTION RESTRICTIONS: All timber offered for sale hereunder is restricted from export from the United States in the form of unprocessed timber and also prohibited from substitution of exported private timber.

CRUISE INFORMATION: The timber volumes for the partial cut units were based on a variable plot cruise for estimating the board foot volume of trees. Plots were measured using a 20 basal area factor (BAF) for partial cut units. None of the total sale volume is salvage material. For merchantable Douglas-fir trees the

average DBHOB is 12.4 inches; the average gross merchantable log contains 38 bf; the total gross volume is approximately 6,901 MBF; and 96% recovery is expected. The Right-of-Way volume is based on a 3-P cruise for estimating the board foot volume of trees.

CUTTING AREA: 9 units totaling approximately 290 acres are partial cut and 12 acres are Right-of-Way. Acres shown on Exhibit A have been computed using a Trimble Pro XH Global Positioning System receiver. Acreage was calculated based on Global Positioning System traverse procedures including differential correction.

CONTRACT TERMINATION: A revised Special Provision has been added to the contract which enables the Contracting Officer to suspend the contract to facilitate protection of certain plant or animal species, and /or to modify or terminate the contract when necessary to:

1. Comply with the Endangered Species Act, or;
2. Comply with a court order, or;
3. Protect occupied marbled murrelet sites in accordance with the Standards and Guidelines of the Salem District Record of Decision (ROD) and Resource Management Plan (RMP), or;
4. Protect species which were identified for protection through survey and manage and/or protection buffer standards and guidelines established in the ROD and RMP.

This contract provision limits the liability of the Government to the actual costs incurred by the Purchaser which have not been amortized by timber removed from the contract area.

DURATION OF CONTRACT: Will be 36 months for cutting and removal of timber.
