<u>LOG EXPORT AND SUBSTITUTION RESTRICTIONS</u>: All timber offered for sale hereunder is restricted from export from the United States in the form of unprocessed timber and also prohibited from substitution of exported private timber.

<u>CRUISE INFORMATION</u>: The timber volumes were based on 3P cruise method in the Partial Cut Areas, 100% cruise in the Right-of-way areas and in the Salvage areas for estimated board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Approximately 5% of the total sale volume is salvage material. With respect to merchantable trees of all species; the average tree is 11.3 inches DBHOB; the average log contains 34 bd. ft.; the total gross volume is approximately 1,490 MBF; and 93% recovery is expected.

<u>CUTTING AREA</u>: Two units totaling approximately 65 acres shall be partial cut and approximately 4 acres of Right-of-Way shall be cut. Acres shown on Exhibit A have been computed using a Trimble R1 Global Positioning System receiver. Acreage was calculated based on Global Positioning System traverse procedures including differential correction.

<u>DURATION OF CONTRACT</u>: Will be 36 months for cutting and removal of timber.

<u>LOCATION</u>: The Laurel Mountain Timber Sale is located approximately 7 air miles northwest of Falls City, Oregon. From the Black Rock mainline, turn right at approximately the 8.5 mile marker onto BLM road 8-7-6.2. Drive approximately ³/₄ of a mile and turn right onto BLM road 7-7-31. See general vicinity map and Exhibit E for details.
