

ORDER**SPECIAL REGULATED CLOSURE RESCINDED****SPOKANE DISTRICT BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT**

The **regulated fire closure** on lands administered by the Spokane District Bureau of Land Management has been lifted effective 12:01 a.m. October 16, 2012 in the following Eastern Washington counties: **Adams, Asotin, Benton, Columbia, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Lincoln, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Okanogan.**

In the following counties: **Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Okanogan, and Yakima** campfires are allowed in established campgrounds only.

The **Liberty** campground remains closed until further notice.

As always caution of operation of motor vehicles on roads and trails with vegetation and high grasses and assurance that camp fires are out before leaving an area are still required.

Pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.3(a), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- **Persons with a permit that specifically authorized the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
- **Any federal, state or local officer or a member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.**

This order will be effective 12:01 a.m. October 16, 2012. **Enforcement Plan:** Posting at locations throughout affected areas.
