### **Eastern Washington Resource Advisory Council Meeting Scheduled for June 1**

The Eastern Washington Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will hold its next meeting on Friday, June 1, 2007, at the Old Town Hall, 104 West First Avenue, Odessa, WA 99159. The meeting will start at 9:00 a.m., adjourn at approximately 11:00 a.m., and will be open to the public. There will be an opportunity for public comments at 9:30 a.m.. The Council will discuss proposals for development of motorized routes on public lands in the vicinity of Odessa, WA. After the meeting, the Council will visit the area where these trails are being proposed.

The Eastern Washington RAC is comprised of 15 members from a variety of backgrounds who are appointed by the Secretary of the Interior. The Eastern Washington RAC reviews overall planning and proposed activities on federal public land in eastern Washington and provides advice to the BLM and USDA Forest Service.
