Subject: Wild Horse and Burro Compliance

The FY2004 Mandatory Random Compliance List has been received from the National Business Center in Denver. Oregon and Washington (OR/WA) have been assigned to do 75 on the ground compliance checks of untitled animals. It is extremely important that all districts complete their assigned inspections and send a copy to the Burns District Office for entry into the Wild Horse and Burro Information System (WHBIS) database. Vale and Spokane may continue to do their data entry at the district level or forward it to the Burns District Office for assistance.

Compliance information entered into WHBIS is used for many internal and external reports regarding accomplishments within the Wild Horse and Burro Program. It is critical that OR/WA stay on top of their compliance workload and have all information documented in WHBIS in a timely manner.

On the ground compliance inspections include those completed to certify care for issuance of title and certifications for cause of death as well as routine inspections for the listed animals.

Attached you will find a copy of the mandatory compliance list. Each district is responsible for contacting those adopters located within their jurisdiction. If you have questions or need a copy of the Private Maintenance and Care Agreement for an adopter, you may contact the Burns District Office at (541) 573-4456.

We appreciate your extra effort and attention to this high priority project.

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Districts with Unions are reminded to notify their unions of this Information Bulletin and satisfy any bargaining obligations before implementation. Your servicing Human Resources Office or Labor Relations Specialist can provide you assistance in this matter.
