The Government Printing Office (GPO) printing and binding regulations (U.S. Code Title 44) require that these semiannual reports be forwarded to the Committee no later than 60 days after the close of the reporting periods (April-September and October-March).

The Joint Committee on Printing (JCP) Report No. 2 covers any procurement of printing and related services that were made directly from commercial sources from April 1, 2005, through September 30, 2005. This would include promotional products, silkscreen items, and large duplication and/or printing regardless of the intent, purpose, or audience. Do not include any SPA (GPO Simplified Purchase Agreement) procurements. Any Bureau of Land Management or Forest Service office that made an independent printing procurement from a commercial source must report this activity on the JCP Report No. 2. All printing procurements must be reported regardless of cost. (There is no \$1,000 exemption to this reporting requirement.)

You are asked to provide negative reports for tracking purposes. Please send your report to the Communications Office (OR-912), Attention: Cliff McClelland, Printing Specialist, by November 10, 2005, for consolidation and submission to the Bureau and Department.
