Subject: Logging Systems and Roads Training DD:01/14/2008

The Forest Service (FS) has announced the 2008 Sale Area Harvesting and Layout Institute (SAHLI) and has reserved five slots for participants from the Bureau of Land Management Oregon/Washington State Office (SO). Although we are limited to five participants per module, the same employee need not necessarily attend all three separate modules.

The FS Email announcing the training and containing a detailed agenda was forwarded to the District Forestry Leads. Some further refinement of the agenda may occur. Note that some weekend travel and training is involved. The three modules are:

We ask that each district office with a forestry program, including Public Domain districts, submit a nominee, or negative response for this training opportunity. The SO will select the participants from the submitted applications. Each district is limited to one applicant per module. Districts are encouraged to consider any resource specialist as an appropriate candidate if logging/roads skills enhancement would effectively support the planning and execution of timber sales. Applications are to be submitted to Lyndon Werner (OR-931) through the District Forestry Lead by COB, January 14, 2008.

The SO will cover tuition and travel expenses. Due to the current uncertainty surrounding travel ceilings, annual work plan allocations of funding to districts may occur for travel expenses.
