Subject: Recreation Management Areas Spatial Data Standard

This Information Bulletin (IB) announces the new Oregon/Washington (OR/WA) spatial data standard for Recreation Management Areas (RMA). There are two kinds of RMAs, Special Recreation Management Area (SRMA) or Extensive Recreation Management Area (ERMA). The data standard defines how this type of data is to be captured in a Geographic Information System (GIS) geodatabase, defines attributes used, and defines coding schemes (domains). An earlier IB (OR-2014-034) provided a draft of the data standard and draft geodatabase for a statewide review period.
