



The Heart of Kiger Gorge, Oregon

 Kiger Gorge is just one of five deep canyons dissecting Steens Mountain located in southeastern Oregon. The heart of Kiger Gorge illustrated in this map typifies the dramatic nature of these gorges, which were created by mountain glaciation and other geologic events during the last ice age. More than 2,000 feet deep, Kiger Gorge offers a unique opportunity for experiencing high desert solitude and breath taking views of dramatic landscapes. Exploration is limited to hiking or horseback riding since there are no formal trails.
