Federal Recreation Advisory Committee To Meet by Teleconference Feb. 2

PORTLAND – A regional federal recreation advisory committee will hear proposals to establish or change user fees on three national forests when it meets on Tuesday, Feb. 2.

Proposals for new and increased fees will be presented by the Deschutes, Umpqua and Okanogan-Wenatchee national forests.

The Pacific Northwest Recreation Resource Advisory Committee makes recommendations on new recreation fee proposals or changes to fees on public lands managed by the U.S. Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management in Oregon and Washington.
