## PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

**Women of the Oregon Trail:** A lecture exploring the role of women on the Oregon Trail.

**The Original Meals on Wheels:** A demonstration of the various methods in which Pioneers preserved, prepared, and partitioned food on the Oregon Trail.

**Art of the Oregon Trail:** The Interpretive Center is full of reproductions of wonderful art depicting the Oregon Trail period. Join a staff member for an interpretive discussion to learn the stories behind various paintings and what artists convey to us about the epic adventure of the journey west to the Oregon country.

**Lincoln's Birthday Celebration:** Thursday, February 12, 2009 10AM-2PM. Special day of celebration for Abraham Lincoln's 200<sup>th</sup> birthday with programs and auditorium presentations throughout the day, essay and poster contests, Lincoln Period Tea and Cake.

**Oregon Birthday Celebration:** Saturday, February 14, 2009 10AM – 2PM. Free Fee Day. Special programs throughout the day related to Oregon Statehood including “**Why Oregon**”, a performance of the state song of Oregon “**Oregon, My Oregon**”, period clothing, timeline and representative documents. Birthday Party with cake and fun served.

**Making Moccasins Workshop:** Learn how to make your own moccasins! This workshop goes from 11AM-3PM with a 45 minute lunch break (please bring your own). Space is limited to 10 participants, and registration closes February 25<sup>th</sup>. There is a \$30 fee which includes supplies and entrance to the Interpretive Center, so please come early and enjoy the new Flagstaff Gallery exhibit. ### **In the Leo Adler Theater:**

Special interest videos on historical subjects, regional interest topics, and natural history shown daily.

**Flagstaff Gallery: “Pack Your Wagon: Critters, Costumes, & Curiosity”**, pack and repack a full-size wagon replica. Map your route to Oregon along a 20-foot long magnetic map of the Oregon Trail. Try on pioneer costumes and pose for a photograph. Animal track rubber stamp activity, wildlife memory game, and piles of animal puppets add to the experience. Opens February 23, 2009 and continues through to early summer season.
