Holiday closures and winter vacation activities at Interpretive Center

Baker City, Oregon: The National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center will be closed for the afternoon of December 24, all day December 25, and January 1st for the holidays. The Center will be open all other days of the holiday vacation week, with films on western lore shown each day in the Leo Adler Theater.

A special workshop for families is offered during the school vacation week on Wednesday, December 30th from 1:00-3:00 pm. "Feed the Birds" will include a hands-on activity making simple bird feeders, and, weather permitting, a short guided hike to explain bird habitat, winter survival of birds, and basic bird watching techniques. If weather is inclement, a talk and film will be shown inside. There is no charge for the workshop, but pre-registration is requested by calling 541-523-1843.

The National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center, operated by the Bureau of Land Management, is located 5 miles east of Baker City, Oregon on Highway 86. Take Exit 302 from I-84. The Center is open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Admission for adults is \$5, seniors are \$3.50, children 15 and under are free. Federal passes are accepted.
