Equine or Bovine?: Interpreter Calvin Henshaw portrays a pioneer pondering the pros and cons of different draft animals. See how he made the choice of which animal to use to power his wagon across the country.

The Original Meals on Wheels: NHOTIC Interpreter Rachael Nickens presents a 30 minute program in the Leo Adler Theater exploring the methods by which Pioneers preserved, prepared, and partitioned food on the Oregon Trail.

Conversations Around the Campfire: Join NHOTIC Interpreter Cheri Garver for conversations about the Oregon Trail, stories about overland emigrants, and hints to help you explore your own genealogy.

Women of the Oregon Trail: Join Interpreter Rachael Nickens for a 40 minute interpretive talk on the roles of women traveling the Oregon Trail.
